### • **Introduction:**

I am delighted to present the Annual Report for the academic year 2025-2026. This year has been marked by exceptional achievements and significant progress across all academic domains at our institution. I will take you through this during the next ten minutes.

### • **Academic Progress:**

This year, our school saw unprecedented academic success, highlighted by a significant rise in student GPAs and standardized test scores, alongside a historic number of School acceptances. Students benefited from a rich array of enrichment programs, exploring diverse interests through Music, Arts, Humanities, and gained broader perspectives from guest lectures and field trips.

We prioritized student well-being, offering extensive support services to ensure a nurturing environment. As we look to the future, our focus remains on educational excellence and innovation, ready to meet evolving student needs with the continued support of our dedicated faculty and vibrant school community. This year Grade 10 result is the testament of our academic achievement. We had achieved 100% results in the very first year. **M. Thanuja** stood school first with percentage of **92.6**.

Our school consistently maintained a high academic standard, and this year is no exception. We have continued the foundation course of **IIT** for the children of grade **VI – IX**. We have started the Grade 11 this year with 30 students. We offer the following courses in grade XI. MPC, BiPC, MBiPC and EAB. We offer JEE and NEET integrated courses in grade XI.

### • **CBSE Activities:**
